

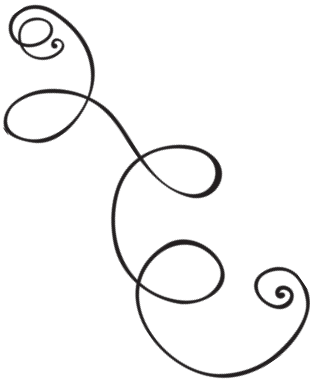

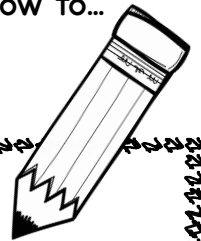
Here is an example: Never will I
