
FLIP It ... ORDOR IT TOACHOR SUIDO

This game is great for practicing ordering numbers. I like to have my kids play in groups of 4 but you could also play in groups of 3.

Each group will need a deck of cards with the face cards removed. Aces are ones.

Each player flips 4 cards from the stack and writes their 4 digit number in standard form. Once everyone has flipped and recorded, they write the numbers in order from LEAST to GREATEST. The person with the SMALLEST number gets a point.

Be sure to encourage your kiddos to talk out their reasoning behind their order! I have found that math talk makes all the difference.



FLIP It ... ORDOR It

Each player flips 4 cards from the stack and writes their 4 digit number in standard form. Once everyone has flipped and recorded, work as a team to write the numbers in order from LEAST to GREATEST. The person with the SMALLEST number gets a point.
